The following resolution was offered by Janice Herzog, seconded by Susan Stanczyk, to wit:

RESOLUTION SELECTING FIRMS TO ASSIST WITH AUDIT SERVICES

WHEREAS, Onondaga County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of the 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended (the "Enabling Act") and Chapter 435 of the Laws of 1970 of the State of New York and Chapter 676 of the Laws of 1975, as amended, constituting Section 895 of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of manufacturing, warehousing, research, commercial and industrial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York (the "State"), to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, in 2020 the Agency issued a request for proposals from qualified firms to provide audit services to the Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Agency received proposals (the "Proposals") from Grossman St. Amour CPAs, PLLC and Bonadio & Co., LLP (the "Responding Firms"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a resolution duly adopted by the Agency on December 8, 2020, the Executive Director entered into a retainer agreement with each Responding Firm for a term of one year; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director and Agency staff have recommended to the members of the Agency that the Agency re-reappoint for a two-year term Grossman St. Amour CPAs, PLLC as auditor (“Auditor”) and Bonadio & Co., LLP as alternate auditor (“Alternate Auditor”); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONONDAGA COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Agency hereby re-appoints for a two-year term Grossman St. Amour CPAs, PLLC as Auditor and Bonadio & Co., LLP as Alternate Auditor. The Executive Director is authorized to enter into retainer agreements with Grossman St. Amour CPAs, PLLC as Auditor and Bonadio & Co., LLP as Alternate Auditor pursuant to which Grossman St. Amour CPAs, PLLC as Auditor and Bonadio & Co., LLP as Alternate Auditor will provide auditing services on an as needed basis until December 31, 2023.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.

The Resolution was thereupon declared duly adopted.


