THIS is to certify that the ONONDAGA COUNTY

INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY has been established by special act of the New York State Legislature, and the following is set forth pursuant to Section 856 of the New York State Industrial Development Agency Act:

1. The special act establishing the Agency was passed May 1, 1970 by Chapter 1030 of the Laws of 1969 which became effective May 1, 1970.

2. The name of the agency is: ONONDAGA COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY.
