

**Access to Videoconferencing

The public hearing is being held in connection with the following matter:

**PUBLIC HEARING WITH RESPECT TO ALLOWING ACCESS TO
MEETINGS BY VIDEOCONFERENCING AS PERMITTED UNDER
OPEN MEETINGS LAW.**

Chapter 56 (Part WW) of the Laws of 2022 of the State of New York added Section 103-a to the Public Officers Law (the “Videoconferencing Law”) to allow members of public bodies to participate in meetings by videoconference from a location that is not accessible to the public so long as certain conditions are met. Pursuant to the Videoconferencing Law, prior to the Agency authorizing the use of videoconferencing to conduct its meetings, the Agency, among other things, must hold a public hearing pursuant to the Videoconferencing Law with respect to said videoconferencing and the Agency must establish written procedures that will govern the use of videoconferencing to conduct its meetings.

The Agency will at the above-stated time and place hear all persons with views in favor of or opposed to the Agency's use of videoconferencing to conduct its meetings in accordance with the Videoconferencing Law.
