Dear Mr. Tamblin:

Thank you for your submission of the Capacity Assurance form for the above referenced project. Based on your response, the proposed use of the site will release an average of 60,000 gallons of wastewater per day (gpd) or approximately 21.9 million gallons of wastewater per year (gpy) into the sanitary sewer network. A summary of the infrastructure path to treatment is as follows:

Wastewater Treatment Plant: Metropolitan Syracuse (Metro)

The location of the proposed development falls within the Metro wastewater treatment plant's service area, a flow-constrained asset. The Onondaga County Department of Water Environment Protection (WEP) requires that all new development within this area offset new wastewater entering into the system on a 1:1 basis. Please work with WEP's Division of Flow Control to explore options as to how to arrive at this offset requirement. Upon approval of an offset plan, WEP is prepared to accept the additional wastewater proposed through this project.

This acceptance is based on County infrastructure capacity only. This letter shall be valid for a period of 24 months commencing from the date of this letter. If construction has not been completed in this 24-month period, please contact this department to apply for an extension.
