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1.0 INTRODUCTION

The OHB Redev, LLC is proposing to redevelop the former Shoppingtown Mall into "District East" (Project). The Project site is located in the Town of Dewitt, east of Erie Boulevard and south of Kinne Road. The proposed Project focuses on transforming the approximately 69-acre property into a blended, multi-use site that will include retail space, medical/office space, residential, hotel, grocery, and entertainment.

2.0 WATER DISTRIBUTION

2.1 Existing Conditions

Water to the existing 1,184,426 Shoppingtown Mall is served by two water mains, one from Kinne Road at the north property boundary (8-inch) and a second from Erie Boulevard at the west property boundary (10-inch). The Town of Dewitt owns and operates the water distribution system and purchases water from the City of Syracuse and Onondaga County Water Authority.


2.2 Proposed Condition

The proposed development will be comprised of a mix of uses including residential, entertainment, restaurants, hotel, retail, medical office, and office space. It is determined that the domestic water required to serve the site will be based on fire flow requirements for the site. Domestic water supply volume requirements are significantly lower than the fire flow requirements due to the demand rate of fire flow. A preliminary evaluation of domestic fire flow was conducted for each proposed use based on the square-foot of building area and required fire flow values. The existing water service is sufficient to provide fire flows that meet regulatory requirements. The fire flow calculations are provided in attachment 1.

To meet the increased demand, the proposed redevelopment project will connect to both the Erie Boulevard and Kinne Road water mains via a new 10-inch water main which will serve the site as schematically shown in attachment 2. This creates a looped system within the project site and provides redundancy in the event of a water main break. Additional service laterals will be provided to each facility within District East. Design details including lateral size and locations will be provided in future design phases and coordinated with the Town of Dewitt Water Department.

The Town of Dewitt has committed to continue to provide domestic water and fire service to the redevelopment site as outlined in their letter dated June 24, 2022 (attachment 3).
