David Balcer: My question conversely would be how much is Bodycote investing in the project. I see what they are exempt from from OCIDA and us but.

Public Hearing Officer Suits: For the record I supplied the cost benefit analysis for the public to view. So you see the total project cost on number 7 after the second black line. Then it shows you what the abatement cost is and total new investment.
