

BODYCOTE SYRACUSE HEAT TREATING CORPORATION

**RESCINDING RESOLUTION
(3101-19-08A)**

A regular meeting of the Onondaga County Industrial Development Agency was convened in public session, remotely by conference call or similar service pursuant to New York State Executive Order 202.87 on January 12, 2021, at 8:00 a.m., local time.

The following resolution was offered by Victor Ianno, seconded by Fanny Villarreal, to wit:

RESOLUTION OF THE ONONDAGA COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY TO RESCIND A PRIOR RESOLUTION REGARDING A CERTAIN PROJECT FOR BODYCOTE SYRACUSE HEAT TREATING CORPORATION (THE "COMPANY").

WHEREAS, Onondaga County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of the 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended (the "Enabling Act") and Chapter 435 of the Laws of 1970 of the State of New York and Chapter 676 of the Laws of 1975, as amended, constituting Section 895 of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of manufacturing, warehousing, research, commercial and industrial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job

opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York (the "State"), to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish its stated purposes, the Agency is authorized and empowered under the Act to acquire, construct, reconstruct and install one or more "projects" (as defined in the Act), or to cause said projects to be acquired, constructed, reconstructed and installed, and to convey said projects or to lease said projects with the obligation to purchase; and

WHEREAS, Bodycote Syracuse Heat Treating Corporation, a Delaware corporation (the "Company"), submitted an application on behalf of itself and/or entities formed or to be formed on its behalf (the "Application") to the Agency which Application requested that the Agency consider undertaking a project (the "Project") for the benefit of the Company and/or entities formed or to be formed on its behalf, said Project consisting of the following: (A)(1) the acquisition of a leasehold interest in an approximately 3.19 acre parcel of land located at 8 Dwight Park Drive (tax map no. 019.-04-11.5) in the Town of Geddes, Onondaga County, New York (the "Land"); (2) the renovation of the current building on the Land, including upgrading the power and gas services to facilitate the Company's thermal processing services (the "Facility"); and (3) the acquisition and installation therein and thereon of related fixtures, machinery, equipment and other tangible personal property (collectively, the "Equipment") (the Land, the Facility and the Equipment being collectively referred to as the "Project Facility"); (B) the granting of certain "financial assistance" (within the meaning of Section 854(14) of the Act) with respect to the foregoing, including potential exemptions from certain sales and use taxes, real property taxes and real estate transfer taxes (the "Financial Assistance"); and (C) the lease (with an obligation to purchase) or sale of the Project Facility to the Company or such other person as may be designated by the Company and agreed upon by the Agency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a resolution duly adopted by the Agency on September 17, 2019 (the "Approving Resolution"), the Agency hereby authorized the Agency, to (A) proceed with the Project; (B) acquire a leasehold interest in the Facility; (C) lease the Facility to the Company pursuant to a lease agreement; (D) acquire, reconstruct and equip the Facility, or cause the Facility to be acquired, reconstructed and equipped, as provided in the lease agreement; and (E) grant to the Company the Financial Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Company has notified the Agency that the Company is withdrawing its Application with respect to the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONONDAGA COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Agency hereby rescinds the Approving Resolution and revokes the grant of Financial Assistance authorized therein.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
