Cicero Energy Storage I, LLC Acquisition or retention of an in interest in approximately 91 acres of land; Construction of a 5-megawatt photovoltaic solar power facility, and battery storage system, including solar panels, power conversion unit, transformers, inverters and other appurtenances; Acquisition and installation therein and thereon of related fixtures, machinery, equipment and other tangible personal property.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing pursuant to Section 859-a of the New York General Municipal Law will be held by the Onondaga County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") on the 6th day of May, 2020 at 10 a.m., local time, via Zoom meeting #95843343945, or dial in at 1-929-436-2866, in connection with the following matter:

Cicero Energy Storage I, LLC (the "Company") filed an application with the Agency requesting that the Agency consider undertaking a project (the "Project") consisting of: (1) acquisition or retention of an in interest in approximately 91 acres of land located at Totman Road and Northern Boulevard in the Town of Cicero, Onondaga County, New York (the "Land"); (2) construction on the Land of a 5-megawatt (MW) photovoltaic solar power facility, and battery storage system, including solar panels, power conversion unit, transformers, inverters and other appurtenances (the "Facility") and (3) acquisition and installation therein and thereon of related fixtures, machinery, equipment and other tangible personal property (the "Equipment") (the Land, the Facility and the Equipment being collectively referred to as the "Project Facility").

The Company will be the initial owner and/or operator of the Project Facility.

The Agency has not made a decision with respect to the undertaking of the Project or the granting of the financial assistance.

The Agency will at the above-stated time and place hear all persons with views in favor of or opposed to the Project and/or the Financial Assistance. A copy of the Company's application including a cost/benefit analysis is available at the office of the Agency for review by interested persons. This public hearing will be held by remote means, by Zoom meeting and telephone conference call, in accordance with the modifications to Article 7 of the Public Officers Law (the


“Open Meetings Law”) as modified by N.Y Governor Andrew Cuomo’s Executive Order 202.1 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. A copy of a recording of the hearing will be available on the Agency’s website.

Public Hearing Officer Lowery asked if anyone had any comments in favor of the proposed project. She stated if you would like to comment you can unmute by hitting *6. She stated if anyone would like to speak on behalf of the project please unmute *6. There were none. Public Hearing Officer Lowery then asked if anyone wanted to speak in opposition to the proposed project. She stated you may unmute by hitting *6. She repeated if anyone like to speak in opposition to the proposed project please make your interest known by hitting *6 to unmute. There were none. Public Hearing Officer Lowery then asked if anyone wanted to make any general comments about the proposed project and you may do so my hitting *6 to unmute. She repeated if anyone would like to make general comments for the record please make your interest know by hitting the unmute *6. There were none. The Public Hearing Officer also noted no written comments had been received as of May 6, 2020 regarding the project.
